Zero Tolerance Policy

The JYFL Board of Directors has unanimously approved a "ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY" related to inappropriate behavior at practices, games and JYFL sponsored activities. The Board feels that league officials, parents and coaches should be proactive in seeking a sage and instructive environment for children without the threat of violence, inappropriate behavior or language on the sidelines.

While most inappropriate behavior is obvious, the actions that will not be tolerated include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Parents and fans on the field without permission
- 2. Inappropriate language
- 3. Yelling negative comments at the referees or opposing player
- 4. Trashing fields, parking areas or any facility
- 5. Attending events intoxicated or smelling of alcohol
- 6. Physical displays of aggression or threats of physical aggression
- 7. Any action that officials or coaches deem to be inappropriate or the individual has previously been asked to stop doing.

Any player, coach, official, parent or fan participating in inappropriate behavior will be ejected from current activities. In cases where the offending party does not leave the area, then the league will notify police and have the offender removed. In the event of a reoccurrence and the same person is ejected twice, they will no longer be allowed to attend JYFL events.

The JYFL hopes these policies will ensure a safe, tolerable environment for your family to be around and your children to play in. Thank you for doing your part to help.
